and

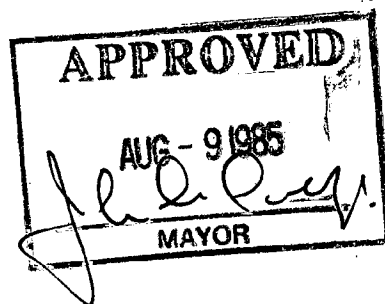
Gordon Avenue from Sayles Street to Oxford Street to accommodate St. Michael's Community Festival.
