The Traffic Engineering Department has received the above resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to replace the existing traffic signal blinker light with a traffic signal control unit at the intersection of Candace Street with Chalkstone Avenue.

Disposition: This intersection is presently on our priority list for the installation of a fully actuated traffic signal system. However, there is not any funding available at the present time, and next fiscal year's budget will be even tighter. We are hoping that there will be some Federal/State monies available to aid the city with these priority cases.
