Approved April 1, 1983

WHEREAS, The National Association of Hospital Admitting Managers was formerly organized on April 5, 1974, at Jamaica Hospital in New York City, and held its first annual meeting in Chicago in 1975, and

WHEREAS, There are some One Thousand Five Hundred Fifty (1,550) Hospital Admitting Managers in the nation, and they have contributed much to the improvement in procedures and the growth of service in United States Hospitals, and

WHEREAS, The NAHAM has developed a successful accreditation program that has been instrumental in changing qualifications for hiring, with most hospitals now requiring a NAHAM accredited Admitting manager, and




WHEREAS, The organization's standards for hospital admitting departments are under study for acceptance by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals,
