WHEREAS, Captain Geremia has also been awarded The Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry by the South Vietnamese Government, for Conspicuous Heroism Displayed on Several Occasions, between February and July, 1968 and

WHEREAS, Captain Geremia, a native of the Silver Lake section of Providence is a graduate of LaSalle Academy and of Providence College, Class of June, 1957, with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Economics where as a member of Pershing Rifles and of Special Forces, was the recipient of the Adjutant Generals' Trophy as Best Company Commander and for the Best Company.
