

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 257

Approved April 24, 1986

RESOLVED, That in order to permit the annual festival of historic houses produced by the Providence Preservation Society to be held, vehicular traffic (other than residential local access and Providence Preservation Society buses) shall be prohibited on the following streets on the dates and times indicated below:

May 2 and 3: from 5 p.m. to 10:30 p.m., Benefit

Street between Sheldon and Williams Streets, James

Street between South Main and Benefit Streets and

John Street between Benefit and Thayer Streets.

May 3: from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.: Stimson Avenue

between Hope and Angell Streets, Dimon Place

between Stimson Avenue and Angell Street, Jenckes

Street between Pratt and Benefit Streets and Benefit

Street between Church and Halsey Streets, and

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Providence Police Department is requested to prohibit parking on Hope Street within 30 feet of Stimson Avenue during the hours that vehicular traffic is prohibited on Stimson Avenue in order to ensure the safety of passengers alighting from buses for said festival.
