# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 249

Approved April 15, 1977

WHEREAS, the Providence Lodge No. 3, Fraternal Order of Police is the host Lodge for the 43rd National Conference of the Fraternal Order of Police, scheduled to be held in the City of Providence from August 7 to August 12, 1977, inclusive, and

WHEREAS, the financial obligations of our progressive Providence Lodge No. 3 are such that it needs assistance in raising funds to insure that the National Conference will be remembered as the most progressive and enjoyable Conference ever held in the history of the Fraternal Order of Police,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in the spirit of cooperation, on the part of the City, to aid Providence Lodge No. 3, Fraternal Order of Police and the State Lodge in its fund raising endeavor, the Traffic Engineer is requested to prohibit motor vehicle traffic along the northerly side of Kennedy Plaza, from Exchange Street, Exchange Terrace and Dorrance Street, during the period of June 19 to June 26, 1977, inclusive, to accommodate the Mayor's Second Annual Summer Festival, sponsored by the State Lodge, Fraternal Order of Police Convention Committee.
