Approved November 27, 1975

RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 301 approved April 26, 1975 is hereby amended by adding the following thereto: "The City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Finance Director, be and he hereby is authorized and directed to borrow, from time to time, not to exceed Two Million (\$2,000,000) Dollars, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 92 of the Public Laws of 1975, and to issue the City's notes therefor, signed by the City Treasurer and countersigned by the Mayor and the Chairman of the Committee on Finance; and to renew any such notes, from time to time, as the same becomes due. The money thus obtained is hereby appropriated for municipal dock buildings and facilities as set forth in said Chapter 92.
