RESOLVED, That His Honor the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with any municipality. Under the terms of said contracts, the Providence Police Department will make available to any municipality its incinerator at its dog pound for the purpose of incinerating dogs that have been previously subjected to euthanasia by said municipalities.

It is hereby provided that the fee to be charged by the Providence Police Department shall be \$5.00 per animal that is so incinerated.

Said contracts shall also include such other terms and conditions as may be provided for by His Honor the Mayor and the City Solicitor.
