

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 717

Approved November 26, 1980

WHEREAS, Various Cities, such as Seattle, New Haven, and others, have applied to the Aetna Life and Casualty Foundation, Inc., for grants to help fight arson in their cities, and

WHEREAS, Aetna Life and Casualty Foundation, Inc., has been giving grants to cities and community organizations to help preserve a viable society in which to live, work, and do business, to alleviate arson, and

WHEREAS, Aetna Life and Casualty Foundation, Inc., gives grants to support programs and organizations that can have a real impact in solving social problems and to provide support in a manner that would stimulate others to give, and

WHEREAS, For the special problems of the cities and their residents, they have programs that lead to the reduction of arson rate, improve the effectiveness and efficiency of local government, or develop neighborhood organization's capacity to provide leadership in such areas as economic development, housing and crime reduction, and

WHEREAS, In the City of Providence we have many problems with arson which blight the neighborhoods,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning is requested to study the feasibility of making application to Aetna Life and Casualty Foundation, Inc., in regards to the Community Arson Awareness Program, which said company sponsors.
