CHAPTER 776 BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FORTY-TWO (\$2,942.00) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, ITEM 0.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 776 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 18, 1953, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$29,679,752.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1954", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of Two Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Two (\$2,942.00) Dollars to the appropriation contained therein for TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, ITEM 0.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Two Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Two (\$2,942.00) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Two Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Two (\$2,942.00) Dollars.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

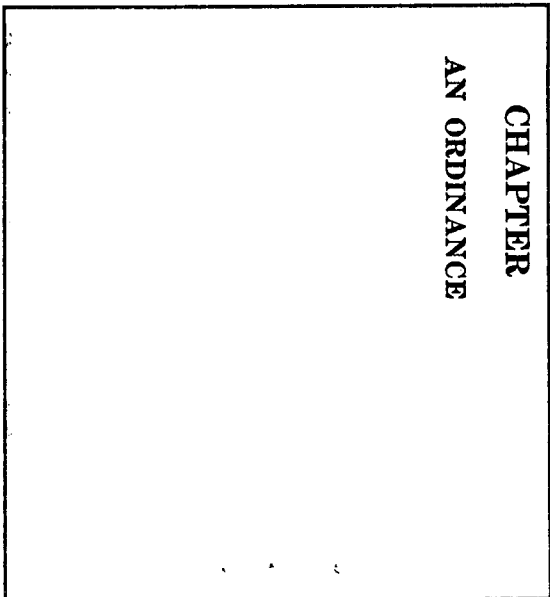

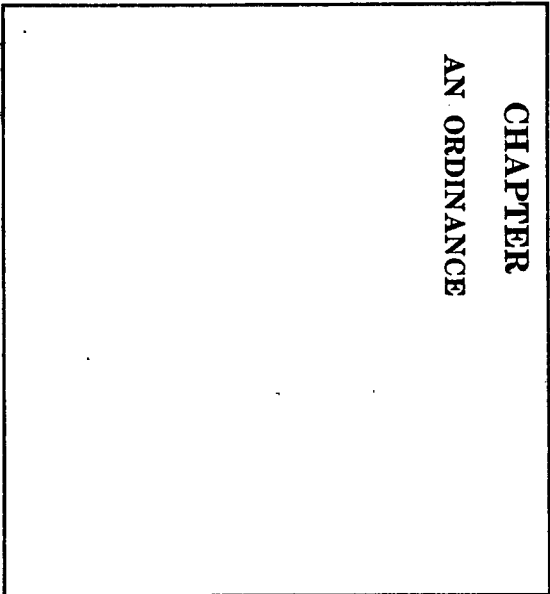

OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE APPROVED
SEPTEMBER 21, 1951, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ZONING
THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AND ESTABLISHING USE, HEIGHT
AND AREA REGULATIONS."

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 approved September 21, 1951 entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations" is hereby amended by changing from a Commercial C-2 Zone to an Industrial M-1 Zone, lot 580 as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 17; said lot being located on the easterly side of Gano Street.

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Gano Street at the southwesterly corner of lot 580 on assessor's plat 17, thence northerly along the easterly line of said Gano Street, to the northwesterly corner of said lot 580, thence easterly along the southerly line of lot 580 to the harbor line; thence southerly along said harbor line, to the southeasterly corner of lot 580, thence westerly along the southerly line of lot 580 to Gano Street, and the point and place of beginning.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SUBJECT: REFERRAL NO. 528 - ZONING CHANGE ON THE EASTERLY SIDE
OF GANO STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, September 22, 1953.


This referral is a request for a change in zoning from a C-2 Zone to an M-1 Zone of Lot 580 on Assessor's Plat 17, located on the easterly side of Gano Street, and containing a total area of 35,130 square feet.

On the field trip it was found that the area in question is at present vacant. Lot 580 is in city ownership and is in the proposed River Drive Extension route.

The Commission

VOTED: To offer no objection to the zoning change providing the land remains in city ownership, and provided that the usual recapture clause is inserted in the lease of the land. It is further recommended that the land be used only for open storage of a non nuisance type as a protective measure designed against the construction of any buildings.
