In compliance with City Ordinance, I hereby submit the Report of the Personnel Department for the year 1951-1952.

Schedule "I" shows Classifications of Positions, the maximum number of employees allowed, and the number of employees in certain classifications on certain dates in the City Departments of the City of Providence.

Schedule "II" shows analysis of personnel turnover of certain classifications.

In addition to the supervision of these Schedules, the Personnel Director has control of vacations to the effect that all vacations forms must be cleared through this department.

This Department has policed all sick leave forms in accordance with the Ordinances governing them.

Authorization for hospitalization for all City employees has been cleared through this department. Also the Personnel Director sits in with and advises the Committee on Retirement and the Committee on Injured Employees.

Over 2,000 applications for positions have been received and the applicants interviewed personally by the Personnel Director during the past year.
