

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 310

Approved September 7, 2022

WHEREAS, Firefighter Stanley Carmichael joined the Providence Fire Department on March 11, 2013 and is currently assigned to Ladder Co. 8; and

WHEREAS, On July 24 2022, a fire broke out in a 2 ½ story house on Rhodes Street with flames shooting through the roof; and

WHEREAS, The Providence Fire Department immediately responded to the emergency by dispatching Ladder Co. 8 who quickly arrived on site to attempt to get the fire under control; and

WHEREAS, When they arrived on the scene, Firefighter Carmichael identified that there was a victim who needed assistance evacuating the burning residence and promptly jumped into action by ascending a ladder to the balcony of the residence in order to attempt to rescue the trapped man; and

WHEREAS, Firefighter Carmichael successfully reached the victim and was able to assist him out of the house, saving him from potentially severe injuries; and

WHEREAS, The heroic actions of Firefighter Carmichael by taking quick and decisive action to ensure the safety of Providence residents is a reflection of the very best qualities of the Providence Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council hereby awards Firefighter Stanley Carmichael with the Municipal Medal of Bravery for his heroic actions in responding to the house fire on July 24, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council extends its deepest appreciation to the entire Providence Fire Department for their dedicated service to the residents of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon passage, copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of Providence, the Commissioner of Public Safety, and Firefighter Stanley Carmichael.
