RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 522

Approved September 10, 1982

RESOLVED, That Resolution No. 1168, approved December 14, 1979, is hereby amended to read as follows:

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED:

That the following named highway shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, R.I., P.W. Dept. - Engineering Office, Street line Section Plan No. 064100, Dated: November 20, 1979",

VIZ:
Goff Street, from the easterly lines of Lots 144 and 145, easterly to easterly termination, having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway, subject to utilities currently in place shall continue to have an easement as it now exists through the present public highway named Goff Street, and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway," and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper, published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.

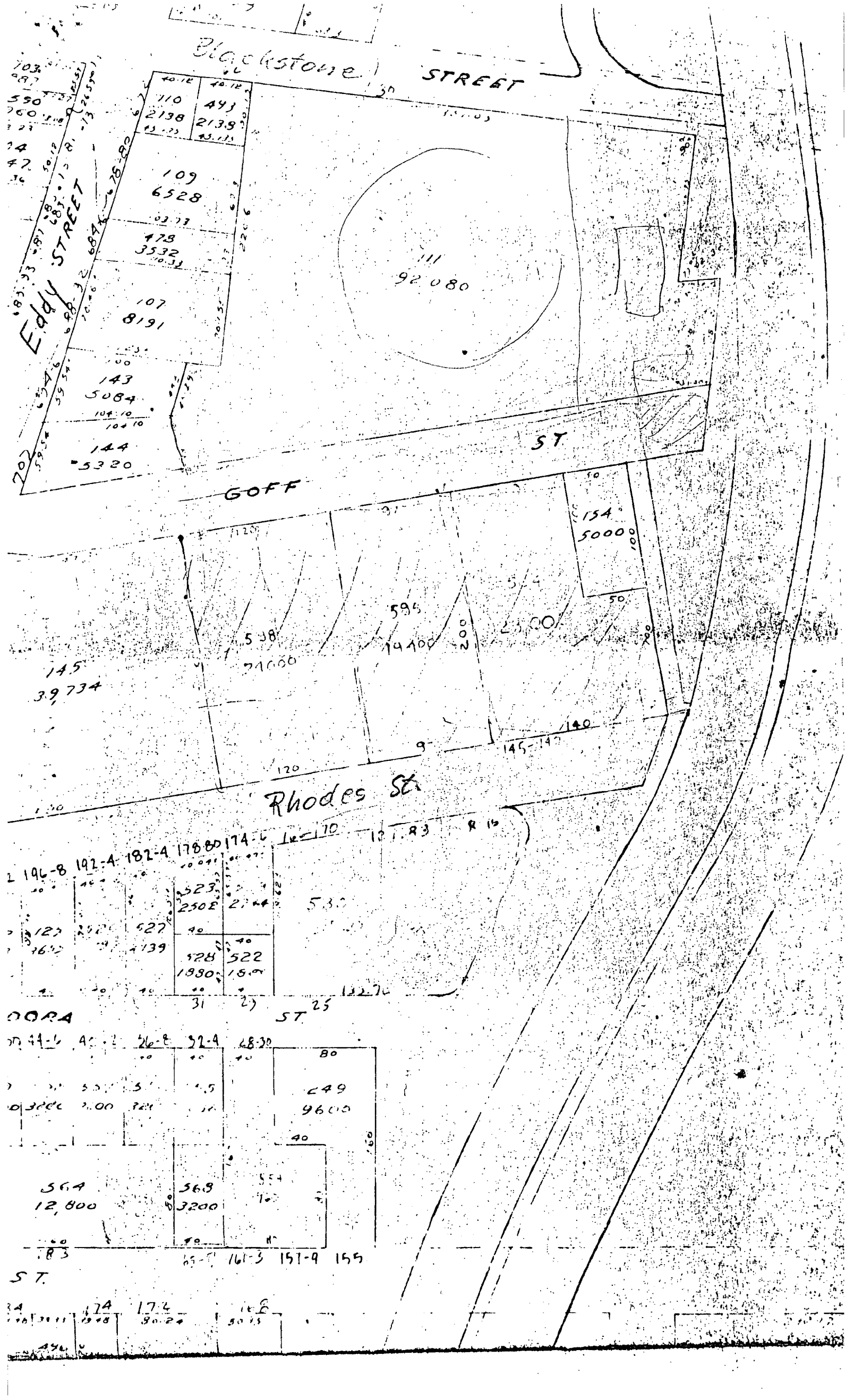

On November 6, 1979 this department received from the City Clerk a memorandum and a copy of petition to abandon as a public highway, Goff Street.
