
Dear Vinnie:



Receipts for the past fiscal year for this court reached the sum of \$70,735.08 which is slightly more than \$15,000.00 greater than last years receipts of \$55,702.36. These receipts were received from a total of 934 new cases as against 941 cases for the preceeding fiscal year.

The number of petitions for probate of will increased from 436 to 455 while petitions for administrations dropped from 276 to 243, and petitions for guardianship also fell from 128 to 93. The balance of the case load was made up as follows: foreign wills 10, administrations in Rhode Island 6, guardians in Rhode Island 3, receivers 1, adoptions 3, conservatorship 13, foreign guardian 3, custodians 3. There were also 68 petitions for change of name.

In the past fiscal year 33 new registry accounts were set up totaling \$57,159.22 of which \$22,768.38 was deposited for absentees and unknown heirs, and \$34,390.84 was deposited for the benefit of minors. As yet no procedure has been established for the transfer of money in the registry of the court to the state under the Eschest law.

During this past fiscal year we have been microfilming records of this court and setting up procedures which will enable us to bring our record keeping up to date.
