

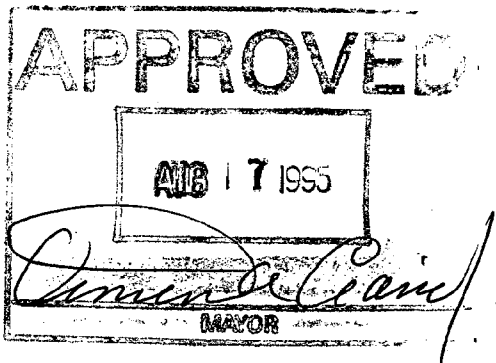

Dear Councilman Jackson,

Recently, Mr. Paul Williams made you aware of our plans to celebrate the 200th anniversary of Bethel A.M.E. Church with a Family Fair to be held on August 12th; and, a parade to receive a plaque presented by Brown University, and a dinner to be held at the convention center in October.

As Mr. Williams may have indicated, we would be honored to have you join us in all of these events. Also, we appreciate your efforts to facilitate these events through your attention to the following:

1) The Family Fair is scheduled to take place on August 12, 1995 (next month) from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. We are requesting that you close areas to vehicular traffic on Rochambeau Avenue and Steele Street. Specifically, the areas closed would begin at the eastern edge of the Bethel Parsonage property line and extend to the North Main Street intersection of Rochambeau Avenue, and that area of Steele Street located between the Steele St. Rochambeau Ave. intersection extending to the Steele St. Lancaster intersection. To allow for set up and clean up time, we would like these areas to be designated solely to our purpose from 9:00 AM to 5:30 PM on Saturday, August 12th.

2) The Parade is scheduled to occur on October 28, 1995. Marchers will begin lining up on Rochambeau Avenue (in front of the church) at 9:00 AM.. The parade will proceed east on

Rochambeau Avenue, south on Camp Street, east on Olney Street, south on Hope and Thayer Streets, and West on Meeting Street to the original site where Bethel's Church was formerly housed (once, part of the Underground Railroad to freedom for slaves). We are requesting that all vehicular traffic be rerouted away from these areas during the parade and the ceremony for the plaque presentation. The plaque presentation will take place on Brown University property next door to the Post Office on Meeting Street. We expect that there will be about 500 people participating in this event.

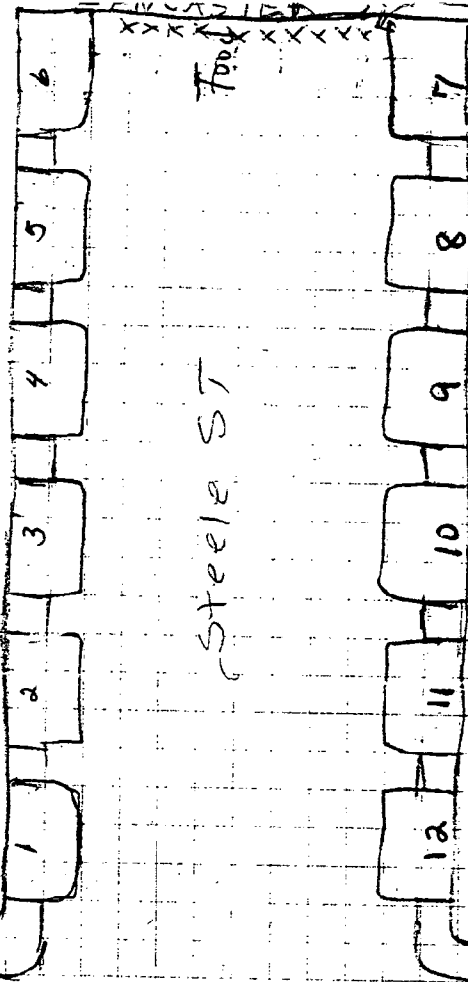

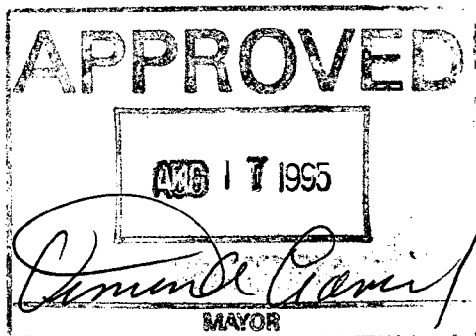
