

Gentlemen:

We have conducted a survey in response to the petition you forwarded to us concerning making Daboll Street a one-way street.

Our traffic counts show that the traffic on Daboll is presently balanced in both directions. There are approximately 100 cars in each direction during peak hours. Based on our survey there are no warrants at present which show that it would be of any benefit to make a traffic change. I feel that more harm than good would result in making Daboll a one-way street. From past experience we can guarantee an increase in the speed of traffic. In addition, we would be increasing the traffic volumes on an adjacent street, and inconveniencing the motorists presently using the street.
