

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved March 7, 1977

WHEREAS, recent public information reported that Challenge Advertising, Inc., has been the recipient of most of the City Advertising in the area of promotional and public relations work, and

WHEREAS, the said Challenge Advertising, Inc., of Providence, has received approximately One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand (\$125,000.00) Dollars from the City of Providence for such commissioned advertising, without the City benefiting by offering this same City business at Competitive Bidding, which is in violation of the provisions of the City Charter concerning purchases in excess of One Thousand, Five Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Committee on Finance is authorized to investigate the reported awards to the Challenge Advertising, Inc., of Providence, for certain City Advertising, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said Committee on Finance is requested to procure from the Purchasing Division, all vouchers and/or authorizations submitted to it, for business awarded to the said Challenge Advertising, Inc.
