Annual report from the Providence Board of Canvassers for the year January 1, 1979 through December 31, 1979.

1. New Registrations taken in 1979	=	3,030
2. Transfers from other districts	=	1,197
3. Transfers to other districts	=	1,194
4. Voters removed because of deaths	=	1,142
5. Voters moved out of City	=	1,447
6. Eligible vote January 1, 1979	=	89,288
7. Eligible vote December 31, 1979	=	89,727

1979 was an off election year in Providence, however this board conducted several special elections.

We completed the certification of the last 4,200 signatures that enabled the Charter Commission question to be put on the ballot at a special referendum on October 22, 1979. This, after many appeals and court challenges that were very time consuming.

In the meantime, this board conducted a primary election on June 5, 1979 and a General Election on July 10, 1979 in the 10th Representative District of Providence.

We also ran another special referendum election for 3 state and 1 local bond issue on June 26, 1979. On July 13, 1979, this board again ran still another primary for the 9th Representative District followed by the Election on August 14, 1979.
