## CHAPTER 1989-29

**No. 601 AN ORDINANCE** Establishing the Classes of Position, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the Water Supply Board and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 1988-36, approved September 8, 1988.

### *Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

Section 1. The number of employees in the Water Supply Board Administration shall not exceed thirteen (13). There shall be no more than:

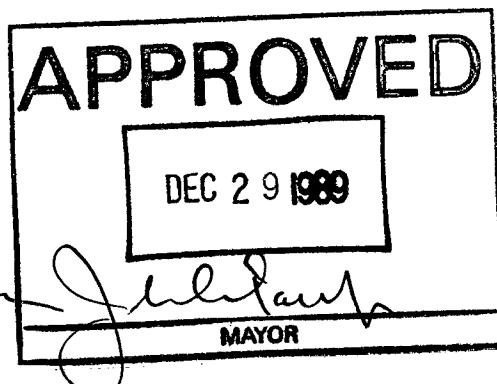
Section 4. The number of employees in the Water Supply Board Planning and Engineering shall not exceed fifteen (15). There shall be no more than:
