No. 601 AN ORDINANCE Establishing the Classes of Position, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the Water Supply Board and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 1988-36, approved September 8, 1988.

Approved December 29, 1989

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:
