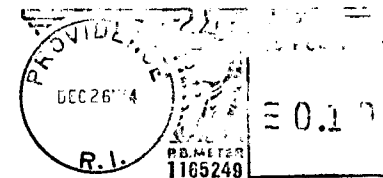

In Re: Lighting Petition for Linden Drive

Dear Mr. Vespia:

I received a directive, on January 10, 1975, stating, no further changes shall be made regarding additional street lighting before first obtaining authorization from the new Director of Public Works, Mr. Daniel E. Healy.

After field investigating, I cannot authorize or recommend anything higher than a 3500 lumen mercury vapor, which we now have on this dead end court.

The 21000 lumen lights are utilized only on our main streets, and certainly I would not have this intensity lights illumination installed on a location such as this.

If the Director of Public Works recommends that I have an additional 3500 lumen mercury vapor luminaire installed on Pole #2 Linden Drive, I shall notify the Narragansett Electric Company.
