



RE: Construction of asphalt surface parking lot to be built over open undisturbed green space.

Dear President Sanchez,

Shortly after your formal installation as the 10th President of Rhode Island College, you and I met to discuss opportunities that we could explore to ensure that the College and City continue in a spirit of cooperation and partnership. RIC is a great institution of higher learning. The people of Providence and the residents of the Fifth Ward in particular, are proud to have you call our neighborhood home.

Nonetheless, the events of recent weeks, where by all indications, the College is unilaterally forging ahead with construction plans is contrary to the spirit of cooperation which has existed for sixty (60) years back when the College first move into the Fifth Ward in 1958.

To unilaterally construct an asphalt surface parking lot to be built over open undisturbed green space to accommodate one hundred fifty (150) or more vehicles when the college has not filed or complied with its obligation to submit an Institutional Master Plan every five (5) years is disconcerting. Particularly where the City's Comprehensive Plan, which has been approved by the State of Rhode Island, includes a provision that newly constructed surface parking lots that accommodate ten (10) or more vehicles are to be discouraged and scrutinized thoroughly.

Had the College complied with its obligation in the first instance and filed its Institutional Master Plan: neighbors, stakeholders, City Planning Commission officials and the public would have had an opportunity to review the plans and comment. It would have afforded the community at large to be engaged and an opportunity for the college to hear neighbors' reactions. But regrettably, the College never afforded its neighbors and community partners that opportunity.

Therefore, please find enclosed a petition presented to me that was circulated and signed by 167 residents and stakeholders of Mt. Pleasant, Fruit Hill and the surrounding community. It has been filed with the Clerk of the City of Providence. The petition was also entered into the record of


the North Providence Town Council at its August 1, 2017 meeting. Neighbors are opposed to the construction and raise valid concerns about the proposed plan's negative impacts on the surrounding neighborhood and environment, including: the creation of a new asphalt hot spot, detracting from the City's storm water management control, and the negative impact on wildlife due to the unstudied destruction of trees and vegetation.

By all indications, construction of the asphalt surface parking lot has commenced. I make this assumption based upon the numerous complaints I have received from your immediate neighbors complaining about loud and disturbing construction activity that began at the early hour of 6:00 A.M. the morning of August 1, 2017. I have received reports that large construction vehicles were allowed access to the campus construction site, by RIC officials, through the Sheffield Avenue gate in Providence. Folks are also reporting that rats displaced by your construction are now invading the neighborhood creating a health and sanitation hazard.

Based upon all of the above, please accept this letter as a formal request that Rhode Island College cease and desist all construction of the proposed parking lot immediately.

You are herein further instructed to submit an accurate and current Institutional Master Plan within ninety (90) days as requested by Providence City Council Resolution sponsored by the undersigned and unanimously approved July 20, 2017 of which a copy is enclosed for your review and records.




