Providence Mayor Vincent A. Cianci, Jr. today announced the appointment of Mr. Daniel Libutti of 354 Mt. Pleasant Avenue, Mrs. Jane B. Sherman of 254 Irving Avenue and Mr. James J. Doyle of 25 Cold Spring Street to the City Planning Commission. Mr. Libutti will serve until January 1st, 1984, Mrs. Sherman will serve until January 1st of 1985 and Mr. Doyle until January 1st, 1982. "These are three outstanding members of our society," said Cianci, "who have contributed enormously to the life of our city in many, many ways. Mr. Libutti, a graduate in Civil Engineering from the University of Rhode Island, is Vice President of Reynolds Metals Development Corporation and Group Manager of the Weybosset Hill Project. He has worked for the betterment of a significant change in our newly revitalized downtown area of the city, and he and his wife, Joan, and their three children live in the Mt. Pleasant neighborhood of Providence.

Mrs. Sherman, a graduate of Mt. Holyoke College, came to live in this city in 1968 to raise a family with her husband, Deming, a much respected lawyer.
