This marquee will be extended beyond the building three feet, six inches (3'6") and would be thirteen feet, 6 inches (13'6") above the sidewalk.

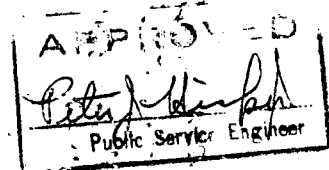
Enclosed you will find plans of marquee as designed by the Office of Ira Rakatansky, A.I.A.

the following named person, firm or corporation is hereby granted permission to erect, alter or use a building or structure at the location named herein for the sale of petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil and their products, compounds and components as described and shown in and on the application therefor and accompanying plat, all on file in the office of the Inspector of Buildings subject to the conditions that said person, firm or corporation shall not violate any of the laws of the State of Rhode Island or any of the Ordinances of the City of Providence relative to the erection, use or occupation of said structure and that said person, firm or corporation shall not allow petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil or their products, compounds or components, to be conveyed over or across any sidewalk by means of any pipe or hose, and upon such special conditions as are hereby enumerated, viz:

Ward 13: Robert L. Walker, 507 Broadway, Plat 35, Lot 462, remove 3-1,000 gallon gasoline storage tanks and install 1-2,000, 1-3,000, and 1-4,000 gallon gasoline storage tanks, making a total storage capacity of 9,000 gallons upon the premises; and two filling pumps, making a total of four pumps on the premises.

The erection or location of any buildings or structures not shown on the original plat on file with the Inspector of Buildings or any change in the location of buildings or structures from that shown on said plat shall be deemed a violation of this permit.

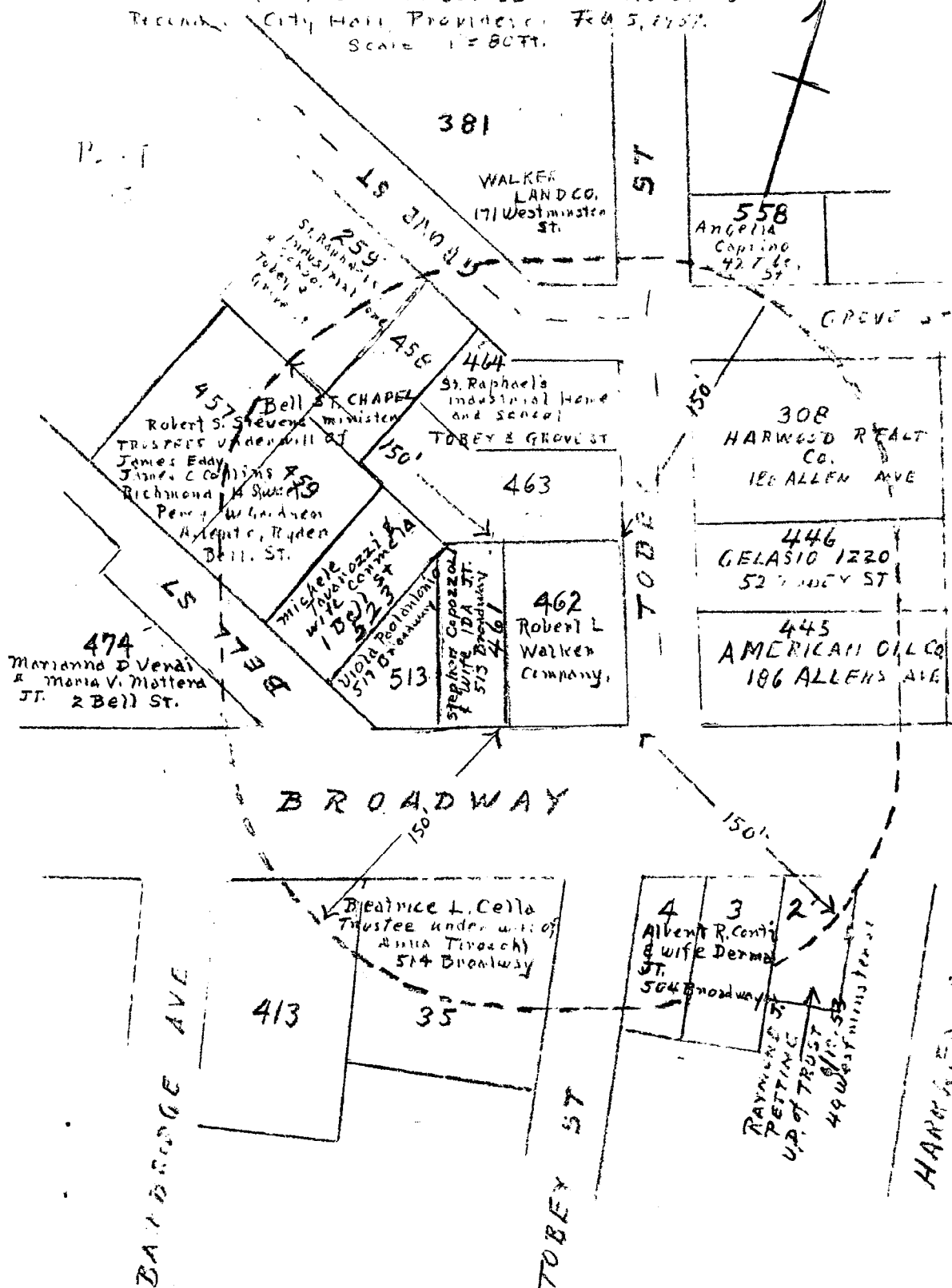

At a meeting of the Zoning Board of Review held on Tuesday, February 5, 1957, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, Robert L. Walker, owner of Lot 462 on Assessor's Plat 35 on the northwesterly corner of Broadway and Tobey Street (507 Broadway) in a Residence R-4 Zone, on December 10, 1956, filed an application for permission to be relieved from the requirements of Section 23 1-3 (a) under the Zoning Ordinance in the proposed modernization of the gasoline station located on the above described premises; and to replace present three underground gasoline tanks of 1,000 gallons capacity each, with one 2,000, one 3,000 and one 4,000 underground gasoline storage tanks; and to relocate the existing gasoline pumps near the street line of Tobey Street on to a new location 15' back from the street line of Tobey Street, and to add two pumps 15' back from the street line of Broadway, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on this application by the Zoning Board of Review at its meeting held on Tuesday, February 5, 1957, after public notice as provided by the Zoning Ordinance,

RESOLVED: That the Zoning Board of Review does hereby make a variation of the use district regulations under the Zoning Ordinance and does hereby grant the application of Robert L. Walker in accordance with the plans, plat plan and parking plan filed with said Board. A copy of said plans, plat plan and parking plan are hereby made a part of this resolution and filed with the Inspector of Buildings.

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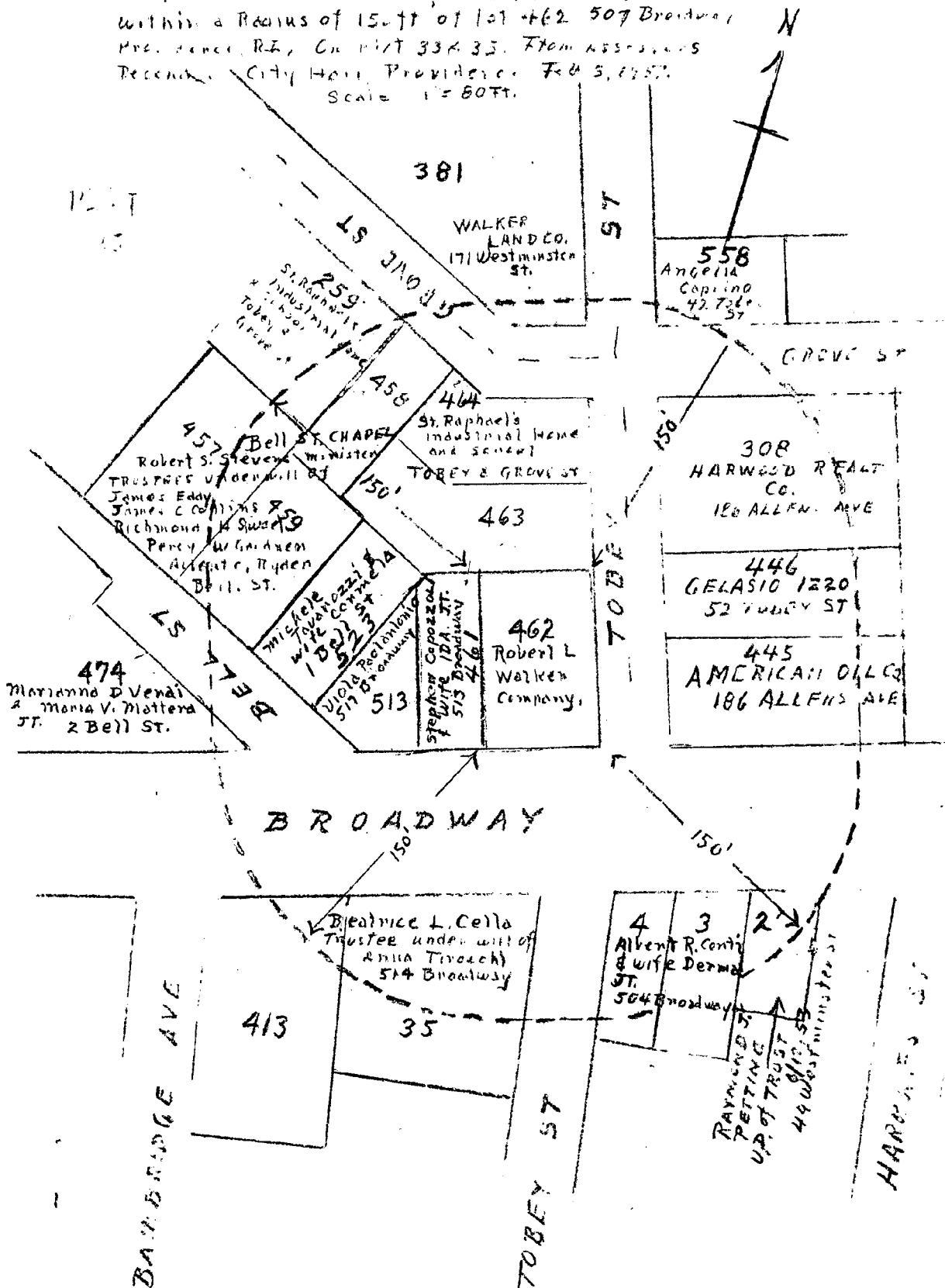
