### QUARTERLY REPORT OF THE QUALITY OF MILK SOLD IN PROVIDENCE BY RETAIL DISTRIBUTORS

The following table gives the results of the average of analyses made by this department during the fourth quarter of the year 1961:

No distributor's name is listed under a particular grade of milk unless at least four samples of that grade were analyzed during the quarter. The standard plate count of colonies of bacteria is obtained by using the logarithmic average set forth in the United States Public Health Service Milk Code.

#### CERTIFIED MILK

The legal standards for Certified Milk are those adopted by the American Association of Medical Milk Commissions, Inc. and in effect at the time of production.

Unless otherwise indicated on the label it shall contain an average of 4.0% of butter fat with a minimum of 3.5% for individual samples and a minimum of 12% of total solids.

The average bacterial count of Pasteurized Certified Milk shall not exceed 500 colonies of bacteria per cubic centimeter.

#### GRADE A MILK—PASTEURIZED

Grade A Pasteurized milk is produced on farms scoring not less than 85% using the dairy score card of the U. S. Department of Agriculture. The butter fat shall average not less than 3.50% for any four samples taken in a period of not less than 30 days or more than 90 days. The bacteria count shall have a logarithmic average of not greater than 10,000 for any 4 consecutive samples.

The Milk Solids Not Fat shall average 8.50%.

**PASTEURIZED MILK**

The average bacteria count of pasteurized milk at the time of delivery to the consumer shall not exceed 25,000 per cubic centimeter and the average per centum of butter fat shall be not less than 3.25 per centum by weight.

The Milk Solids Not Fat shall average 8.25%.

## PASTEURIZED SELECTED MILK

Under state law only three grades of milk are recognized, Certified, Grade "A", and Regular. Milk may also be classified as homogenized, skim, or defatted. Buttermilk and Cultured Buttermilk are other recognized types defined by state law. Goat milk is also defined. All milk sold in the City of Providence is required to be pasteurized.

While there is no separate legal classification of Pasteurized Selected Milk, some dealers utilize this "grade" as a price differential. Check this grade with dealer's Grade "A" or Regular.

\* Previous reports were in terms of Total Solids. This year the change over was made in our reports to agree with the state law. This accounts in part for the sharp increase in violations recognized in Grade A "SOLIDS NOT FAT."

**REMARKS**

During the past year this department purchased a Fiske Milk Cryoscope. This is a precise electronic instrument designed to give a rapid determination of the freezing point of milk and thus the possibility of added water. We have set a base of  $-0.530^{\circ}\text{C}$  and any freezing point above this figure is indicative of added water. For example, a freezing point of  $-0.520^{\circ}\text{C}$  in a milk would lead us to believe that water has entered this milk to the extent of 2%.

We have investigated several of these situations and found that in the pushing of milk from a short time pasteurizer, carelessness on the part of the operator can cause some water to enter the milk during this procedure.

Extreme care should be taken by all milk dealers to see that the volume of water used is correct and that the time needed to remove the milk is accurate.

Dear Mr. Whelan:

This is an answer, as requested by Councilman Lorenzo, to submit a report on our findings of City Council Resolution No. 199 namely, the requested relighting of Messer Street with mercury vapor street lights.

The first petition was received on May 19, 1961, for relighting Messer Street, and at that time we found the street to be adequately lighted with regular 1000 lumen street lights and marked the petition, "Hold for future expansion."

The second petition was received June 27, 1961, for a survey of lighting in the vicinity of #22 Messer Street and found that at this particular location 2500 lumen lights were doing an adequate job, and the petition was denied.

The third petition was received March 16, 1962, for a survey of existing lighting on Messer Street to determine if improved lighting is necessary, and mercurys were requested by the Councilman. Our field survey disclosed that Messer Street is lighted at the present time with 2500 lumen lights from Westminster Street to Oak Street to the junction of Union Avenue and Messer Street with 1000 lumen lights. This we consider as safe as any secondary street in regards to traffic and pedestrian safety.

I trust that this report will be acceptable to Councilman Lorenzo.




