RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 111

Approved February 11, 1998

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED

That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence Plan, Rhode Island Department of Public Works-Engineering Office, street line section Plan No. 064570 dated November 9, 1995

Viz: Manilla Street, (portions of), shown as a cross-hatched area on accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A) having ceased to be useful to the public and is proposed to be abandoned as public highway, said abandonment is specifically conditioned precedent upon the following:

(1) Petitioner shall tender the amount of Six Thousand Three Hundred Eighteen Dollars and Fourty Cents (\$6,816.40) in legal tender U.S. currency to the City of Providence.

(2) The Petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the Narragansett Electric Company which will permit retention of its facilities in their existing location, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same with twenty-four (24) hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should be determined by the Petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation.

(3) The Petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the Providence Water Supply Board which will permit retention of its facilities in their existing location, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four (24) hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be determined b the Petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the Petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation.

(4) That the Petitioner shall meet each of the conditions to which reference is made in that communication from the Providence City Plan Commission dated November 27, 1995, (a) before road construction begins the petitioner must install a retaining wall that will edge Manilla Street and 128 Lubec Street; (b) The Petitioner shall provide a landscape strip along the northern lot line of 128 Lubec

We have reviewed the Petition to Abandon a Portion of Manilla Street for potential impact on the Providence Water Supply Board (PWSB) system. Our records indicate that this portion of Manilla Street - has in place a PWSB 6-inch water main. Accordingly, this main must remain as situated in the event the abandonment is approved.

Therefore, the PWSB has no objection to the proposed street abandonment, provided that the petitioner grant a full utility easement to the PWSB to maintain, construct, repair, etc. the existing water main and appurtenances, and that no permanent construction, whatsoever, be allowed within the easement. Wording of the easement shall be subject to review by the PWSB as to form and content.

Dear Mr. Clement:

We have reviewed the referenced Petition for impact on the Providence Water system. Our records indicate that Providence Water owns and maintains a 6-inch asbestos cement water main that is located where the abandonment and regrading is proposed, generally north of Lubec Street in the City of Providence. A residence at 15 Manila Street has its water service connected to this portion of the main.

Without having the benefit of the Petitioner apprising Providence Water of their plans, the following concerns are raised:

- ◆ Lot No. 462 on A.P. 79 will be left without any frontage along a public street, in apparent contravention to City Zoning Ordinances. In effect it will become "landlocked."
- ◆ The elevation of the northernmost end of Manila Street is approximately ten (10) feet higher than the parking area of the Admiral Plaza. The elevation of the Plaza opposite the northwest (rear) corner of the house at 113 Lubec Street (A.P. 79, Lot No. 436) is approximately six (6) feet below Manila Street. It is unclear how much regrading is being proposed by the Petitioner and how it will affect the operation of the Providence Water main. Mains are generally placed with fifty-four (54) inches of cover over them.



If this cannot be done, or the Petitioner does not address the concerns noted above, Providence Water objects to the Petition and respectfully requests the City Council not approve the same.

The City Plan Commission at its November 20, 1995 regular monthly meeting reviewed and evaluated the proposed abandonment of a northern portion of Manilla Street located to the north of the rear lot line of Lot 436 on Assessor's Plat 79 and running northerly to the North Providence town line.


The petitioner is Mr. K. Macarthur Coates, Vice President of Douglas Avenue Associates, Inc., and owner of adjacent lot 435 on Assessor's Plat 79.

The petitioner is reconfiguring an access to the commercial development to allow for the construction of a commercial building on lot 435.

A field inspection revealed that subject portion of Manilla Street is a paved public right-of-way serving the adjacent residential properties: Lot 462 and Lot 461. Lot 462 contains a two and half story, two-family structure in good condition. The surrounding one- and two-family dwellings are in very good condition and are located in an Two-Family District (R-2) Zone. Lot 435 is zoned General Commercial District (C-2) and is part of a large commercial plaza located in North Providence along Douglas Avenue.
