# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 82

Approved February 7, 1958

Resolved,

That

any structure above or under the ground hereafter constructed and located in the City of Providence on that tract or parcel of land bounding on Weybosset Street containing approximately 10,346 square feet of land and designated as lot 418 on assessor's plat 24 in use by the City Assessor of the City of Providence and used by the public for the parking of automobiles off the street or highway, shall be exempt from any assessment of valuations and levy of taxes thereon for a period of twelve (12) years beginning December 31, 1957, provided that

1. The construction of such structure results in at least a 200% increase in the parking capacity of the premises as they existed prior to erection of said structure.
2. The exemption shall be limited to that portion of the structure exclusively used for or devoted to the parking of automobiles and vehicles of that nature.
3. The exemption herein granted shall be for such structure whether owned by Lloyd Bliss, Maynard M. Bliss and Robert H. Bliss or any other firm or corporation

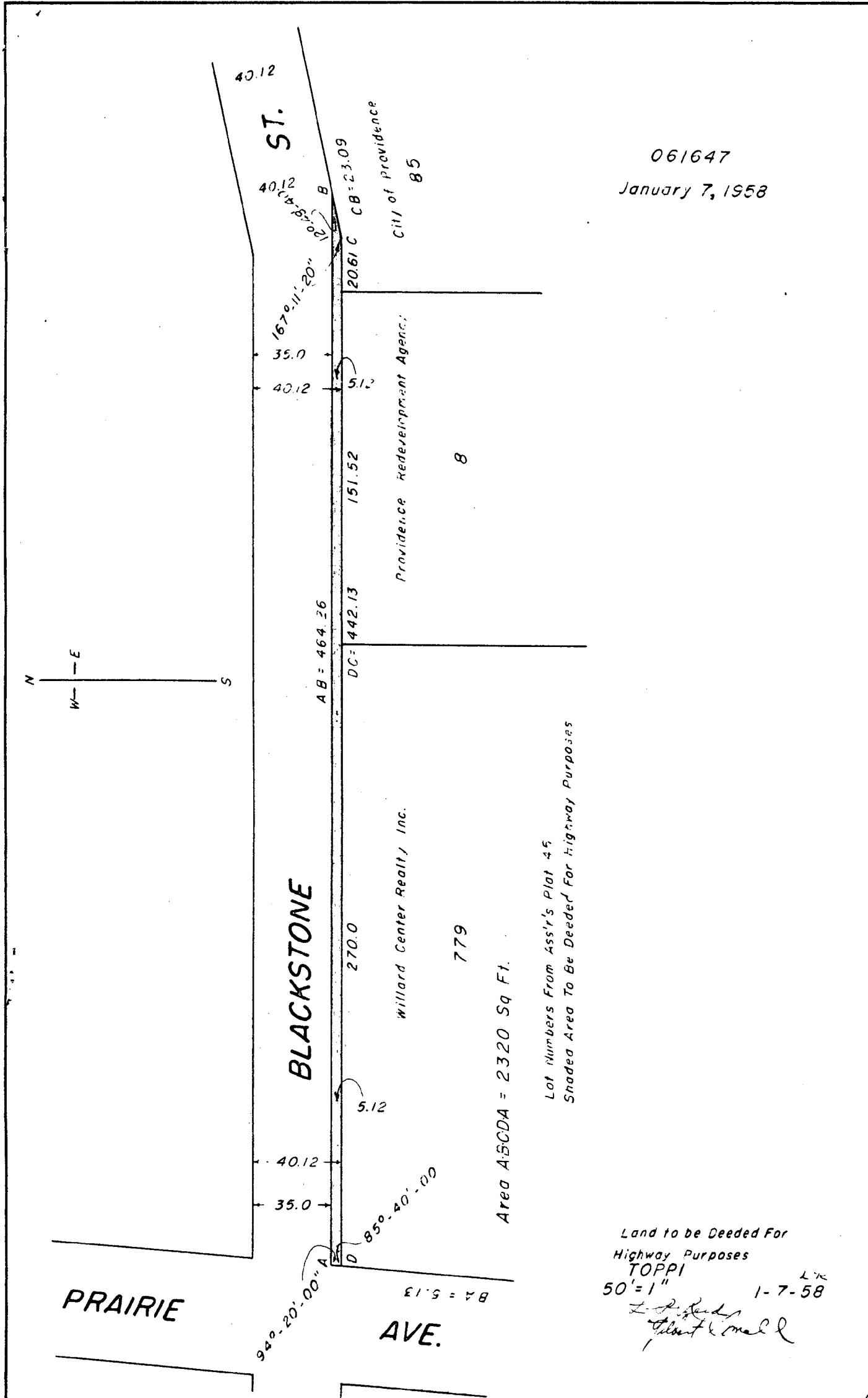
