ELECTION OF PRESIDENT OF CITY COUNCIL

There being no further nominations, on motion of COUNCILMAN LYNCH, seconded by COUNCILMAN FARGNOLI, it is voted that nominations be closed and the Clerk be directed to call the Roll.
