WHEREAS, Thousands of lives have been lost in the past several years in an attempt to gain human rights for all people of Northern Ireland, and

WHEREAS, Bobby Sands and Francis Hughes have died as a result of hunger strikes in Maze Prison, Belfast,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence does pause in its deliberations in memory of these brave young men, and offers prayers for peace in all of Ireland.
