Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations", is hereby further amended by changing from an R-4 Multiple Dwelling Zone to an M-1 General Industrial Zone, Lots 512, 513, 514, 515, 516, 517, 524, 523, 522, 532, 533 and 543, as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 63, as of December 31, 1968; said lots being within that area bounded by Curtis, Bosworth, Aleppo and Sheridan streets, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of Bosworth and Aleppo streets at the southwesterly corner of Lot 543 on City Assessor's Plat 63; thence northerly along the easterly line of Aleppo Street to the northwesterly corner of Lot 524; thence easterly along the southerly line of Lot 525 to the southeasterly corner of Lot 525; thence northerly along the easterly line of Lot 525 to the southwesterly corner of Lot 511; thence easterly along the southerly line of Lot 511 to the westerly line of Curtis Street at the northeasterly corner of Lot 512; thence southerly along the easterly line of Curtis Street to the southeasterly corner of Lot 517; thence westerly along the northerly line of Lot 520 to the southwesterly corner of Lot 517; thence southerly along the westerly line of Lot 520 to the southeasterly corner of Lot 522; thence westerly along the northerly line of Lot 521 to the northeasterly corner of Lot 532; thence southerly along the westerly line of Lot 521 to the northerly line of Bosworth Street at the southwesterly corner of Lot 532; thence westerly along the northerly line of Bosworth Street to the northeasterly corner of Bosworth and Curtis Street at the southwesterly corner of Lot 543 and the point and place of beginning.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 21-63 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, effective October 21, 1968 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 21-63. INVESTMENT OF GENERAL FUND CASH AND SHORT-TERM SECURITIES AND CERTIFICATES OF INDEBTEDNESS.

"The City Treasurer, with the advice and approval of the Finance Director, is hereby authorized to invest, from time to time, in certificates of indebtedness issued by the United States Government, state and local governments, or agencies thereof, or certificates of indebtedness issued by banks chartered under the laws of the United States or the several states thereof, such sums of money in the general fund of the City as may be deemed in excess of the amount required for the payments of current obligations of the City, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that any such investment in securities or certificates of indebtedness from said fund, with a maturity in excess of six (6) months, shall be made only with the approval of the City Council Finance Committee."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
