No. 852 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING A COMPENSATION PLAN FOR
THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, CHAPTER 1974-54, APPROVED AUGUST 9, 1975.

Approved November 27, 1975

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

WHEREAS, the Contract between the City of Providence, Rhode Island and the International Association of Firefighters, AFL-CIO, effective for the fiscal year July 1, 1975 to June 30, 1976 grants increases in salaries of certain Fire Personnel, covered by the subject contract and,

WHEREAS, for the purpose of implementing the Provisions of the said contract, pursuant to Section 3.18 of the Charter of the City of Providence, it is hereby declared that, due to the fact that effective date of this contract, being July 1, 1975 and in order to insure those employees who qualify for increases in salaries under the provisions of the said contract, that they not be duly inconvenienced with additional delay of the benefits accorded to them, it is declared that an emergency situation exists.

SECTION 1. Section 1, of the Ordinances of the City of Providence Approved August 9, 1975 is hereby further amended as follows:
