

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved July 12, 1974

WHEREAS, it has been reported that a ticket scalper, was operating in and around the Providence Civic Center, on the day of the recent Elvis Presley Show, offering and selling five dollar admission tickets for twenty-five dollars each, and

WHEREAS, these tickets, it was further reported, were purchased from a ticket broker in Boston, Massachusetts, for seven dollars and fifty cents each, and

WHEREAS, the scalper, it was further reported sold his tickets within twenty minutes, within the Civic Center Lobby,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chief of the Providence Police Department is requested to assign a police detail in and around the Providence Civic Center for the purpose of eliminating future scalping of admission tickets.
