RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 306

Approved May 10, 1977

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, does hereby endorse the following Acts relating to State Aid to Libraries;

77-H 5708, establishing the level of state aid to free public libraries at not less than forty cents per capita and would take effect July 1, 1977;

77-H 5709, providing that grant-in-aid to interrelated library systems will have a base grant of thirty-thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) and would take effect July 1, 1977;

77-H 5711, increasing the annual grant-in-aid to the Providence Public Library and would take effect on July 1, 1977; and

77-H 5713, classifying the libraries at Providence College, Bryant College and Salve Regina College as special research centers, making an appropriation therefor and would take effect July 1, 1977.
