

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved July 12, 1995

RESOLVED, That His Honor the Mayor is hereby authorized to grant an easement along, above and under a portion of that certain parcel of land located in the Town of North Providence, County of Providence, State of Rhode Island, bounded and described in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part thereof for the purpose to install, construct, maintain, operate, replace, repair, alter, renew or remove an emergency generator. Said easement be granted to the State of Rhode Island, Department of Environmental Management for the sum of Two Thousand, Three Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$2,375.00) contingent upon and shall not become effective until such time as the State of Rhode Island, Department of Environmental Management enters into an agreement with the City of Providence, which shall contain such terms and conditions and which shall be satisfactory in form to the City Solicitor.

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EXHIBIT "A"

That certain parcel of land located easterly of Smithfield Road in the Town of North Providence, County of Providence and State of Rhode Island bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a southeasterly corner of an existing easement owned by the Town of Smithfield for pipe line and pumping station, said point being forty three and $11/100$ (43.11) feet southerly of land now or lately of Gary A. Troiani et ux; thence running westerly along said existing easement a distance of eleven and $86/100$ (11.86) feet to a corner; thence turning an interior angle of $135^{\circ} 00' 00''$ and running southwesterly along said existing easement a distance of twenty five and $65/100$ (25.65) feet to a corner; thence turning an interior angle of $135^{\circ} 00' 00''$ and running southerly along said existing easement a distance of seven and $01/100$ (7.01) feet to a corner; thence turning an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 00' 00''$ and running easterly bounded southerly by land of City of Providence, Longview Reservoir a distance of thirty one and $62/100$ (31.62) feet to a corner; thence turning an interior angle of $93^{\circ} 35' 20''$ and running northerly bounded easterly by said City of Providence land a distance of twenty five and $19/100$ (25.19) feet to a corner; thence turning an interior angle of $86^{\circ} 24' 40''$ and running westerly bounded northerly by said City of Providence land a distance of three and $20/100$ (3.20) feet to the point or place of beginning and contains by computation 650 square feet of land.
