No. 434 **AN ORDINANCE** LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF
TAX ANTICIPATION NOTES ISSUED BY THE CITY.

Approved August 6, 1982

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. No notes may be issued by the City in anticipation of taxes unless the amount of such notes, together with the amount of any other tax anticipation notes then outstanding, shall not exceed in the aggregate seventy per cent of the revenue receipts estimated in the appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year in which such notes are issued, other than for water bills and other earnings of the water supply board, remaining uncollected at the time said notes are issued. The limit set by this ordinance shall be in addition to the limits set forth in Section 45-12-4 of the General Laws and Section 26 of Chapter 1665 of the Public Laws of 1945, as amended.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its Passage.
