CHAPTER 1982-42, APPROVED JULY 7, 1982, BY TRANSFERRING CERTAIN
SUMS OF MONEY WITHIN SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1982-42 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, Approved July 7, 1982, Entitled: "An Ordinance making an Appropriation of One Hundred Fifty-Eight Million, Two Hundred Forty One Thousand, Six Hundred Seventeen Dollars and Sixty-Nine Cents (\$158,241,617.69) for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1983", is hereby amended as follows:
