SUBJECT: Referral No. 1188 - ZONING CHANGE AT 164 BRIDGHAM STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, January 10, 1961.

This referral is a request to rezone Lot 315 on City Assessor's Plat 32 from an R-4 Multiple Dwelling Zone to a C-2 General Commercial Zone; said lot being situated at 164 Bridgham Street. The property in question contains 5,743 square feet of land.

On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that the premises contained a 2½-story frame 3-family dwelling and a 1½-story frame two-stall garage. The adjoining and adjacent residential characteristics have remained unchanged and the dwelling exteriors are being steadily improved to preserve the harmony and stability of the neighborhood.

Reference is made to a previous recommendation dated May 17, 1949 at which time a similar request was submitted to rezone the premises. At that time the location was studied and the Commission Voted: To recommend a denial of this petition and the Commission's recommendation was upheld.

Pattern changes incompatible with established standards are detrimental to the economy and environment of neighborhoods. The change would be undesirable and adversely effect the residential unity of the area. Since the rezoning of this property would have blighting influences within the existing block and since the location of the premises is only across the street from the Central-Classical Project, which is about to be operational,

VOTED: To recommend that this petition to rezone this property be denied.

OF TABER AVENUE

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, November 15, 1960.

This referral is a request to rezone Lots 19 and 26 as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 39 from an R-1 Single-Family Zone to an R-4 Multiple-Dwelling Zone; said Lot 19 being situated on the easterly side of Kingston Avenue and Lot 26 being situated on the westerly side of Taber Avenue, in each instance being located between Lloyd Avenue and President Avenue.

On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that the premises contained a 2½-story frame duplex dwelling and a 4-stall masonry garage.

The granting of this petition to rezone the property in question to a multiple-dwelling use would introduce a less restricted residential use into the City's highest order residential zone. "Spot" zoning has disorganizing influences and is not in accordance with the City's Urban Renewal Plans. In this area where uses are predominantly one-family,
