Gentlemen:

We transmit herewith a copy of a letter which we have sent today to the City Plan Commission of the City of Providence as a result of the publicized statements of Mr. Ralph Matera at a recent meeting of that Commission.

Because of Mr. Matera's responsibilities, not only to his own ward which he represents, but to the citizens of Providence generally in his capacity as a City Councilman, we deem it particularly unfortunate that he has seen fit to maintain and to publish an attitude so rejective of a racial minority's rights to equal access to any housing within their means in the City.

We urge that the City Council censure Mr. Matera for these prejudiced and ill-considered statements, and thus to restore the public's confidence in the City Council's determination to represent all of the City's people impartially and without unfair discrimination based on race, creed, color or national origin in all matters that come before it.

Gentlemen:

The Rhode Island Committee on Discrimination in Housing at its meeting on February 26, 1958, discussed the statements made by Mr. Ralph Matera at the City Plan Commission meeting on the previous day, and reported in The Providence Journal and Evening Bulletin of February 26th.

We are concerned that a member of the City Plan Commission, who in that capacity represents the welfare of every resident and businessman in Providence, should make statements which will in no way help to solve the relocation situation facing the city.

More important, however, is the necessity for the City Plan Commission publicly to dissociate itself from Mr. Matera's private prejudices. Until this step is taken the community can have little confidence in the Commission's ability successfully to carry through its functions in relation to the urban renewal program in Providence.
