RESOLVED, That this Minute on the Life and Character of Edmund Wexler, late retired Member of the City Council from the Eleventh Ward of the City of Providence, who passed from this life on the Eighth Day of January, 1982, be Adopted and Ordered inscribed on the Record of this Meeting of the City Council.

Edmund Wexler was born in Providence in 1907, the son of the late William and Rose Wexler, where he resided until the past two years,

A graduate of Brown University and Harvard Law School, he was admitted to the Bar in Rhode Island and Massachusetts, a profession he practiced with distinction until his retirement due to illness.

"Ed" Wexler served the community as a Member of the City Council, representing the Eleventh Ward of the City of Providence, for thirty years, with dignity.



Having been selected Majority Leader of the Democratic Members, he had an impeccable distinction for leading the members in a most honorable demeanor, with knowledge difficult to exceed and with counsel most respected throughout deliberations.

During his tenure of office as a Member of the City Council, Edmund Wexler served on many Committees and was elected Chairman of the Committee on Ordinances of which his profound knowledge excelled.

Active in Civic and Religious Affairs, he was an Officer or Member of numerous Organizations including Veterans, Democratic and Jewish Groups, in all of which he was an active participant.
