Dear Mr. Lombardi:

I am a resident of North Providence, RI and I'm presently working for the Providence School Department. I have lived in North Providence over seven years. I moved back to Rhode Island after my husband passed away. Providence is my home, so when I came back I started looking for work, in the Providence School Department. I found a temporary position hoping to become a permanent employee. When I became permanent, I began looking for affordable housing in the City of Providence.

It has been extremely difficult to find affordable housing to meet the physical and financial needs of my situation. I have high blood pressure and I'm not able to climb many stairs, so the apartment that I need would have to be a 1st floor or in a building with an elevator. I'm a minority senior citizen, whose health needs have to be considered when finding suitable housing. My probation period will be ending soon and I have not been able to find suitable housing in Providence at this time. I have two problems financial and housing. Many rental properties require first and last month rent up front as well as a security deposit. I live alone and can hardly make ends meet now living from check to check.

I have been unsuccessful at this time to find affordable housing. My apartment is a one bedroom, at ground level, all on one floor, which allows easy accessibility. My rent is \$530 per month, with heat included. I really enjoy working for the Providence School Department as a permanent employee. So I am requesting that you allow me an extension of time in meeting the residency requirements.
