Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations", is hereby further amended by changing from an R-4 Multiple Dwelling Zone to a C-1 Limited Commercial Zone, Lot 65, as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 67, as of December 31, 1968; said lot being situated at 356 Smith Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the southerly line of Smith Street at the northeasterly corner of Lot 65 on City Assessor's Plat 67; thence southerly along the westerly line of Lot 66 to the southeasterly corner of Lot 65; thence westerly along the northerly line of Lot 61 to the southwesterly corner of Lot 65; thence northerly along the easterly lines of Lots 39 and 64 to the southerly line of Smith Street at the northwesterly corner of Lot 65; thence easterly along the southerly line of Smith Street to the northeasterly corner of Lot 65 and the point and place of beginning.


It is the opinion of this department that the introduction of a limited commercial use at this location would have no detrimental effect on this predominantly commercial area.


