JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 19 70

AN ACT

REPEALING A PORTION OF CHAPTER 210 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1969.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 210 of the Public Laws of 1969 entitled "An Act Extending for a One-Year Period State and Local Tax Relief to Interstate Railroads and in Further Amendment of Chapter 46 of the Public Laws of 1961, as Amended," is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.



