

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved February 7, 1964

WHEREAS, John J. Cashman, Finance Director, did arrive at the golden age of City retirement on January 31, 1964, thus officially culminating a most distinguished public service career which included tenures in top level Federal, State and Municipal posts, and
