Approved August 3, 1956

Resolved,

That any structure above or under the ground hereafter constructed and located in the City of Providence on that tract or parcel of land bounding on Washington, Eddy, Worcester and Union Streets, containing approximately 28,060 square feet of land and comprising lots 51, 54 and 58 on Assessor's Plat 20 in use by the City Assessor of the City of Providence and used by the public for the parking of automobiles off the street or highway, shall be exempt from any assessment of valuations and levy of taxes thereon for a period of twelve (12) years beginning December 31, 1957, provided that

1. The construction of such structure results in at least a 200% increase in the parking capacity of the premises as they existed prior to erection of said structure.

2. The exemption shall be limited to that portion of the structure exclusively used for or devoted to the parking of automobiles and vehicles of that nature.

3. The exemption herein granted shall be for such structure whether owned by Parking, Inc., a Rhode Island corporation, or any other person, firm or corporation.
