# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 873

Approved November 27, 1975

RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 300 approved April 26, 1975 is hereby amended by adding the following thereto: "The City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Finance Director, be and he hereby is authorized and directed to borrow, from time to time not to exceed Five Million (\$5,000,000) Dollars, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 90 of the Public Laws of 1974, and to issue the City's notes therefor, signed by the City Treasurer and Countersigned by the Mayor and the Chairman of the Committee on Finance; and to renew any such notes, from time to time, as the same become due. The money thus obtained is hereby appropriated for school purposes as set forth in said Chapter 90."
