WHEREAS, The quality of life in the City of Providence is directly related to the responsiveness of government and its ability to meet the needs and expectations of its residents; and


WHEREAS, The residents of the City of Providence, understand the connection and elect local leaders with certain expectations regarding the service they will provide and the role they will play in their lives; and


WHEREAS, Those elected to serve the City of Providence accept the privilege of service with the understanding of the responsibility and expectations placed upon them by the members of our community; and

WHEREAS, The accountability for the viability, prosperity, and overall well-being of all Providence citizens rests with those who are elected to serve the public.


