# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 526

Approved September 15, 1967

RESOLVED, That Port Drive from Field's Point Drive easterly and northerly to Harborside Boulevard be abandoned in its present location and relocated one hundred (100) feet south of and parallel with its present southerly line, as shown on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, R. I., P.W. Dept.-Engineering Office, City Property Section, Plan No. 063116, dated June 28, 1967".

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on Port Drive from Field's Point Drive easterly and northerly to Harborside Boulevard, abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting Port Drive from Field's Point Drive easterly and northerly to Harborside Boulevard, which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.



This referral is a request to abandon a portion of Port Drive.


On an inspection and photographic survey it was found that Port Drive was not curbed and the northeasterly portion was paved and the southwest to northeast portions were not paved.

VOTED: No objection to the granting of this petition.

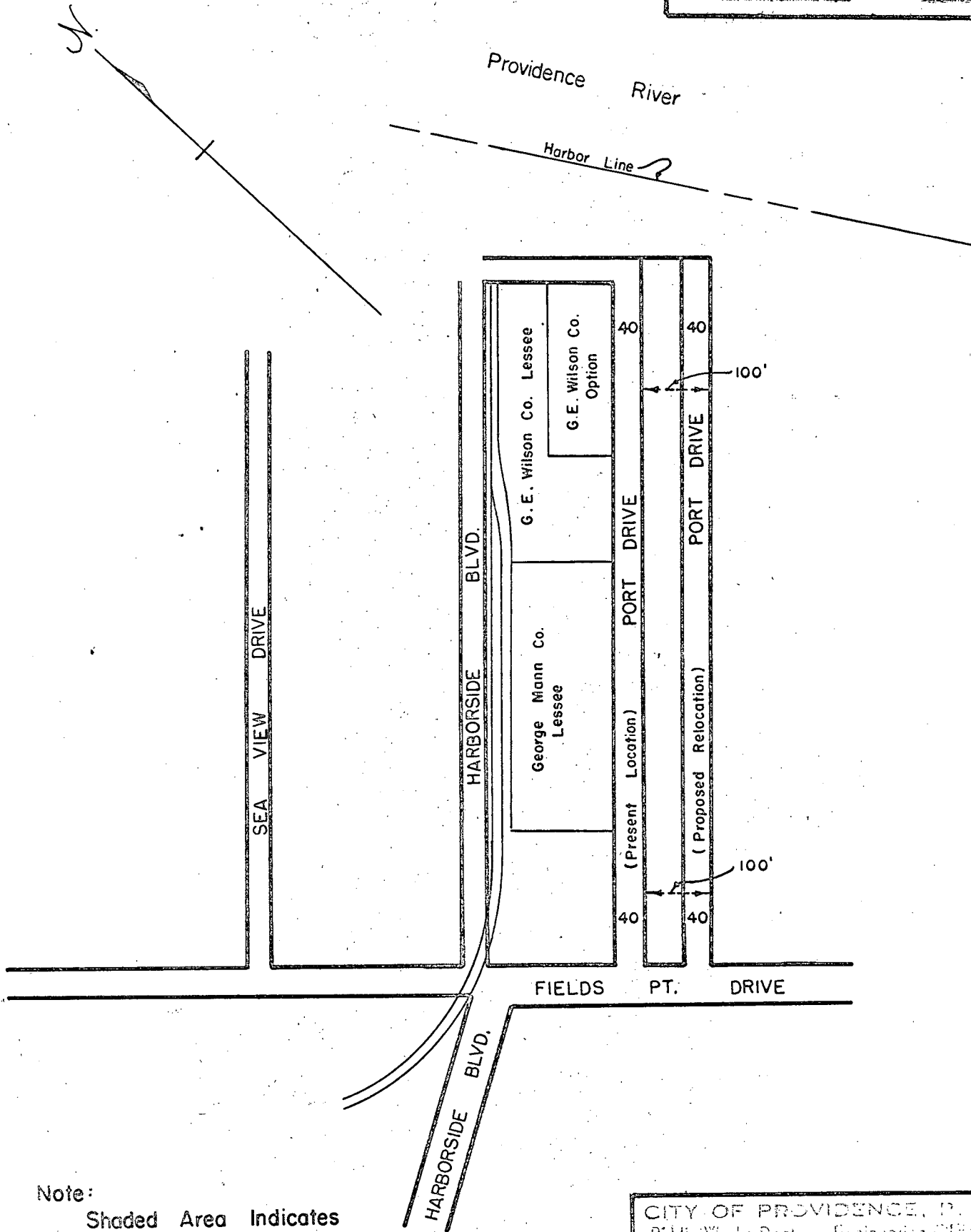
