AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18 OF CHAPTER 1981-40 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENTS, EFFECTIVE JULY 20, 1981, RELATIVE TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

Approved June 30, 1982

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 18, of Chapter 1981-40 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, entitled: "An Ordinance Establishing the Classes of Positions, the maximum number of employees and the number of employees in certain classes in the City departments, effective July 20, 1981, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 18. FIRE DEPARTMENT

ADD: (3) Rescue Captains
DELETE: (3) Rescue Lieutenants

ADD: (1) Fire Prevention Captain
DELETE: (1) Fire Prevention Lieutenant

ADD: (12) Rescue Technicians
DELETE: (12) Rescue Truck Driver

Additionally, next to the Fireman Category an asterick will be inserted and a footnote will be added, as follows:

* Those Fireman who qualify and maintain certification as Emergency Medical Technicians Advanced or Emergency Medical Technician Cardiac shall receive the salary of a Rescue Technician whether or not they serve in the Rescue Division, providing they maintain their certification. Those Fireman who were qualified and certified as EMTC Cardiac shall receive retroactive payment to the date of qualification or April 1, whichever is applicable.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

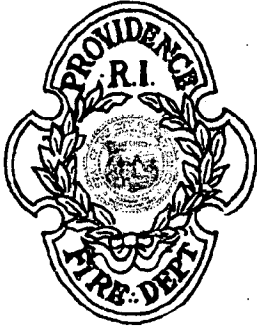

Subject: Job Classifications

Dear Chairwoman Brassil:

At the request of the City Clerk for the Finance Committee, a clarification of the change of classification for certain ranks of the fire department has been requested. The following is respectfully forwarded to clarify and explain the changes in classification of certain uniformed employees of the fire department.

The 1981 union contract required that:

- Three (3) Rescue Lieutenant positions were to be deleted and three (3) Rescue Captains were to be added
- One (1) Fire Prevention Lieutenant to be deleted and one (1) Fire Prevention Captain to be added

Additionally, under the firemen category, an asterik would be added to indicate a Fire-Medic classification which would apply in those cases where firemen would qualify and maintain certification as Emergency Medical Technicians-Cardiac (EMT-C). A salary commensurate with that of a Rescue Technician (Rescue Truck Driver) would be paid to those qualified firemen provided they maintained their certification. Those firemen who were qualified and certified as EMT-Cs would receive retroactive payment to the date of the classification, or April 1, 1981, whichever was applicable.

The salary for the added Rescue Captain will be the same as the salary of a Fire Captain.


The salary of the added Fire Prevention Captain will be the same as that of a Fire Captain.

Further, the fire department has requested that the title of twelve (12) Rescue Truck Drivers be deleted and the title of twelve (12) Rescue Technicians be added. This is merely a classification title change and does not involve any funding.
