

We have completed the investigation which you requested concerning the need for STOP signs at the intersection of Acorn Street and Spruce Street.

Volume counts made at this location show a low volume of traffic on both of these streets. In addition this intersection has a reasonably good accident record. Our records show only six reported accidents in the last four years. Therefore, we do not recommend the installation of STOP signs.




Gentlemen:

We have completed our investigation of your request for STOP signs at the intersection of Camp Street and Carrington Avenue.

Our volume studies do not show an unusually high volume of traffic through this intersection. It has a good accident record, there being but 1 reported accident in 1961 and none in 1962.

In view of the existing satisfactory operation at this location, we do not recommend the installation of STOP signs.



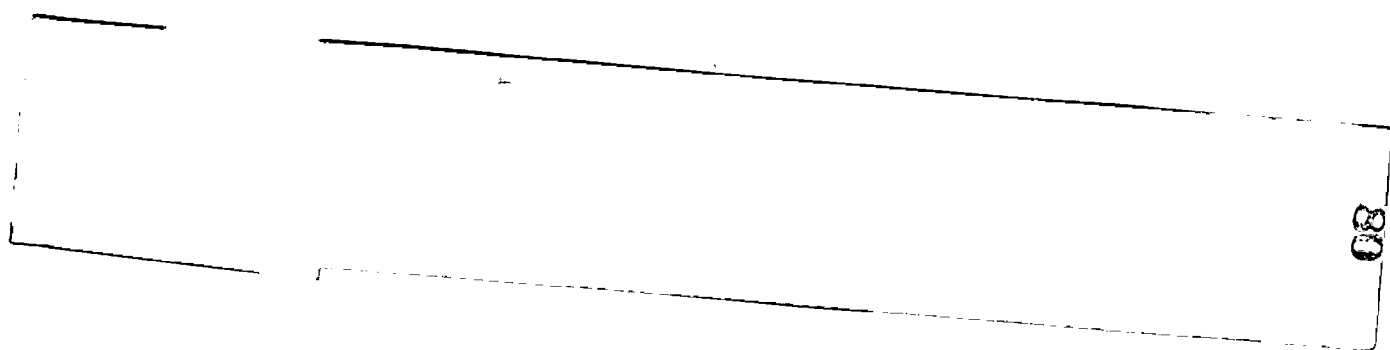


Gentlemen:
