RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 764

Approved December 29, 1978

WHEREAS, Recently the Providence Police Department and the Rhode Island State Police have been the object of uncalled for criticism, by certain groups who are unqualified in law enforcement procedures, and

WHEREAS, These guardians of the civil rights of our citizens should be commended for their courageous and unselfish public service, rather than be the recipients of unearned criticism, not withstanding the unprecedented physical assaults often suffered by our State and Local Policemen, and

WHEREAS, Our dedicated police officers and men should be respected, for their efforts to uphold the law, rather than be the targets of groups, critical of the role of these guardians for the safety of the public, who call upon them for protection, when the occasion presents itself,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That in commending the Rhode Island State Police and the Providence Police for their respective combined efforts in upholding the laws of our State and City, the City Council of Providence are not unmindful of the dedication to duty by the State Police, in the service of the State of Rhode Island and of the Providence Police in the service to the City of Providence, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon the adoption of this Resolution by the City Council and its approval by His Honor the Mayor, the City Clerk is directed to transmit a duly engrossed copy of the same to Colonel Walter E. Stone, Superintendent of the Rhode Island State Police and to Commissioner of Public Safety Leo P. Trambukis, Providence.
